# Valparaiso University Greek Week 2016

All fraternities and sororities are invited to participate in the Valparaiso University Greek Week 2016 celebration. This packet outlines all of the activities, and how points will be awarded to participating chapters.

## Sunday, April 17, 2016:

**Greek Week Window Painting:** 9:00 p.m. in Founders Table

**50 Points**

Three (3) members from every organization may decorate their group's designated window from 9-11pm on Sunday night. The theme of the windows will be: "What represents your organization?" Only **members** of an organization can paint on their window. Each team will be given 50 pts for participation and additional points will be given to those who win (1st = 20 points, 2nd = 10 points, 3rd = 5 points). The winners will be chosen by a panel of judges from the Student Affairs Division. Each team **must** return at the end of the week and clean their window or the chapter will be disqualified.

**Fraternity and Sorority Study Tables** 9:00 p.m. in Community Room

**Up to 40 Points**

Chapter members are encouraged to come to a group study session in the Community Room. Members should sign-in on the sheet provided for each chapter. Members will sit by different colleges (Nursing & Health Professions, Business, Engineering, and Arts & Sciences). As many people can attend as they would like, points will be awarded on chapter attendance (5 points per member present, up to 40 points can be received).

## Monday, April 18, 2016:

**Fraternity and Sorority Trivia Night:** 9:00 p.m. in Harre Union Ballrooms B & C

**50 Points**

Each chapter may send one team of up to 5 members. Each team will be given 50 points for participation and additional points will be given to those who win (1st = 20 points, 2nd = 10 points, 3rd = 5 points).

## Tuesday, April 19, 2016:

**UPC Bingo Night:** 8:00 p.m. in the Harre Union Ballrooms

**40 Points**

Each chapter is encouraged to send 4 members to participate in the UPC BINGO night. Chapters will receive 10 participation points for each member that attends up to 4. Event includes prizes for winners!



## Wednesday, April 20, 2016:

**Fraternity and Sorority Service Project sponsored by Junior Panhellenic**

**50 Points**

Chapter members can visit the Junior Panhellenic table in Chapel View Lounge all day on Wednesday to sign-up to become an organ donor or show documentation (ie: driver's license) indicating that you are already an Organ Donor. Chapters with over 50% signed up will receive the points for this event.



## Thursday, April 21, 2016:

**SAAFE Rally:** 7:00 p.m. in the Harre Union Ballrooms

**100 Points**

Each chapter is encouraged to have 80% of the chapter in attendance for the annual SAAFE Rally. This event also counts towards the chapter's successful fulfillment of the annual Safe and Empowering Organization designation. **Fraternity and Sorority Study Tables:** 9:00 p.m. in the Ballrooms

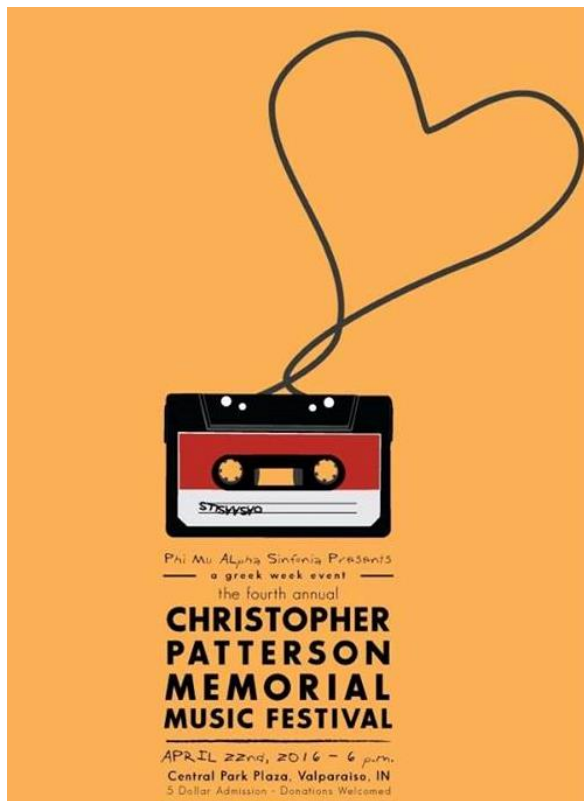
**Up to 40 Points**

This night seating will not be assigned due to the larger number of expected attendees. As many people can attend as they would like, points will be awarded based on chapter attendance (5 points per member present, up to 40 points can be received)

## Friday, April 22, 2016:

**Phi Mu Alpha Chris Patterson Memorial Music Festival**

**Bonus Points**



All chapter members are encouraged to come and support the men of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia at their annual event. The Chris Patterson Memorial Music Festival takes place at Central Park in downtown Valparaiso, and the event will begin at 6:00 p.m. Entrance is \$5.00.

Chapters should take a photo of their members attending the event, tweet it and tag @ValpoGreekLife. Points will be awarded based on a percentage of chapter members in attendance.

## Saturday, April 23, 2016:

**Greek Olympics:** 2:00 p.m. on the Harre Union West Lawn

The following are the events that are scheduled as part of Greek Olympics. Chapters can identify their members for each event team. Chapters that win will receive 20 points, 10 for second place and 5 for third place for each event.

10. Double Dutch Contest: 2 members per group
11. Bring banner
  - a. Must have affiliation name and Valparaiso University on it
  - b. Must include at least 2 different colors
  - c. Include an appropriate slogan that has to do with Greek week/Olympics
